Dear Parents and Patients,

We hope that you all are healthy and returning to some sense of normalcy during these unprecedented times.

We have returned to normal operations; however, many of the Pediatric ENT of Atlanta locations are within a Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (CHOA) pediatric facility, which remained closed.

While we are unsure when CHOA will reopen these locations, we hope it will be soon. In case these building closures are more prolonged than anticipated, we are working on alternative options to serve patients seeking ENT care in their respective neighborhoods.

In the meantime, we are seeing as many patients as possible at our Atlanta Scottish Rite location in Sandy Springs, our Tower Road location in Marietta, our Gwinnett location in Duluth, our Forsyth location in Cumming, and our Old Milton location in Alpharetta.

All consultations, follow-ups, audiological testing, surgeries, and post-operative visits have resumed normal scheduling. For those who cannot travel, we continue to offer Tele-Medicine as an alternative.

We are true to our motto, "*Where Children Are First*" and remain steadfast to continue your child's care in every way possible. As we receive updates from CHOA, we share those with each of you.
